Responsibilities

- Supervise and manage the work of camp monitors and aide-the-camp staff;
- Train and ensure that horses are cared for so that they are fit to be ridden by campers;
- Lead the Cavalier 101 educational workshop every week and support the camp monitors so that they lead our various workshops with a good level of knowledge and professionalism;
- Coordinate and plan equestrian activities according to the children's skill level and ensure that they ride at least one or two (1 2) times during their stay;
- Teach campers the basics of horseback riding, horse physiology, how to handle horses and prepare them for riding and how to maintain the equipment properly;
- Supervise experienced riders as well as beginners and ensure their safety and respect for horses at all times;
- Organize and host horse games;
- Maintain equestrian equipment with the help of camp monitors and campers;
- Assist the farrier and the veterinarian during their visits;
- Create an atmosphere of the most joyful and pure happiness so that life at La Ferme d'André is most memorable.

Prerequisite

- The candidate must ideally have five (5) years of experience in the equestrian field;
- A valid certification from the Fédération équestre du Québec (FEQ) as an instructor or advanced rider is a valuable asset;
- The riding instructor must be available for the full season of the summer camp, four (4) days a week at a minimum, Monday to Thursday, from 8:30 a.m. to 4:30 p.m. He/she should preferably be present during nature class days;
- Have no criminal record related to the position;
- Being bilingual is a valuable asset.

Mandatory Training

- Integration and training meetings planned for May and June;
- ACQ learning modules to be successfully completed before the beginning of the summer camp season.

Employment conditions

- You will be housed and fed at a low cost;
- You will receive a weekly salary, based on your skills and experience.
