Prerequisite

- 🐦 Be 17 years old as of June 1, 2021;
- 🐦 Have no prior criminal record in connection with the position;
- 🐦 Be available full-time from June 27 to August 28, 2021;
- 🐦 Be available for 60-hour training that will take place over a few weekends in the spring
- 🐦 Sleep on site five (5) nights per week, including one (1) in La Grange à Tarzan and one (1) in the dormitories;
- 🐦 Have a positive, constructive and inclusive attitude;
- 🐦 Summer camp experience or group animation are valuable assets;
- 🐦 Being bilingual is a major asset.

Responsibilities

- Early in the morning, the camp instructor must be ready and willing to interact and ensure the well-being of children;
- Ensure that all gatherings run smoothly (breakfast, lunch, dinner, snacks, bonfire, games, emergency and fire drill exercises, etc.)
- Participate and lead group activities and games;
- Prepare and participate in the bonfire every night;
- Help and look after children for bedtime after the bonfire;
- Sleep once (1) day per week in La Grange à Tarzan for the supervision of children;
- Be present on Sundays for the arrival of the children.



Each camp instructor will design, organize and orchestrate daily educational activities according to his specialties:
