









WHAT TO BRING TO THE WINTER CAMP?

The male gender is used in this document simply to lighten the text and make it easier to read it.

IMPORTANT!

-  **IDENTIFY** all items in your child's name: From toothpaste to winter boots to socks and sleeping bags! A quick check will be done when you arrive to ensure that all of your child's items have been identified.
-  Note that La Ferme d'André 2.0 is not responsible for lost items.
-  Don't bring any money, treats, chewing gum, iPod/iPad/iPhone or electronic games.

GOOD TO KNOW !

-  Soap, shampoo, conditioner and washcloths are provided by La Ferme d'André 2.0.
-  Your child will be invited to write letters to family and friends during his stay. In order to mail them, your child will need pre-stamped envelopes. We will be happy to print any email messages received for your child, if applicable.
-  The use of cameras will be allowed at specific times during the week so that our campers can bring back their most beautiful memories. The Administration will therefore keep all devices in a safe place during their stay.
-  Arrivals are scheduled for Sunday between 3:00 and 4:30 p.m.
-  Departures are scheduled for the following Friday night between 6:30 p.m. and 7:30 p.m.

Clothes and basic items identified in the child's name (full name)

- Casual clothing;
- Jackets, polar sweater, pajamas, warm socks, underwear;
- Snowsuit – coat and overalls – optional second overalls;
- Snow boots;
- Tuque, neck cover, scarves, mittens;
- A pair of slippers
- A towel for the shower;
- Toothpaste and toothbrush, hair brush, elastics;
- Reusable laundry bag for dirty clothing;
- Medication (if necessary) to be handed over on arrival.

For sleeping

- One (1) sleeping bag (well identified in your child's name) and one (1) pillow;
- One (1) flashlight.

Other optional items

- Musical instruments.
- Certified sports helmet;
- Snowshoes;
- Cross-country skis;
- HotHands hand and toes warmer bags against the cold.
