












WHAT TO BRING TO THE SUMMER CAMP?

The male gender is used in this document simply to lighten the text and make it easier to read it.

IMPORTANT!

-  **IDENTIFY** all items in your child's name: From toothpaste to rain boots to socks and sleeping bags! A quick check will be done when you arrive to ensure that all of your child's items have been identified.
-  **Note that La Ferme d'André 2.0 is not responsible for lost items.**
-  **Don't bring any money, treats, chewing gum, iPod/iPad/iPhone or electronic games.**

GOOD TO KNOW!

-  **Soap, shampoo, conditioner and washcloths are provided by La Ferme d'André 2.0.**
-  **Sunscreen and mosquito repellent will be applied if forgotten.**
-  **Your child will be invited to write letters to family and friends during his stay. In order to mail them, your child will need pre-stamped envelopes. We will be happy to print any email messages received for your child, if applicable.**
-  **The use of cameras will be allowed at specific times during the week so that our campers can bring back their most beautiful memories. The Administration will therefore keep all devices in a safe place during their stay.**
-  **Arrivals are scheduled for Sunday between 1:30 p.m. and 3 p.m.**
-  **Departures are scheduled for the following Saturday morning between 10 a.m. and 11 a.m.**

Clothes and basic items to be identified in the child's name (full name)

- Play clothes for all types of weather (pants, shorts, long sleeves and short sleeves, jacket, socks, underwear, pyjamas, raincoat, cap or hat);
- Rubber boots, sandals, closed shoes;
- Two (2) swimsuits and one (1) life jacket (mandatory for children who can't swim);
- One (1) beach towel and second (2nd) one for the shower
- Toothpaste and toothbrush, hairbrush, elastics;
- Reusable water bottle;
- Reusable laundry bag for dirty clothing;
- Medication (if necessary) to be handed over on arrival.

For sleeping

- One (1) sleeping bag and one (1) pillow for sleeping inside the dormitory;
- A second (2nd) sleeping bag (well identified) and a second (2nd) pillow are required in the event of one or more -sleepovers in the Tarzan Barn. These items cannot be brought inside the main property;
- One (1) flashlight.

For horse riding and other activities

- One (1) certified riding helmet or one (1) certified bike helmet that is of proper size, properly adjusted and identified with full name;
- Shoes or boots (rain or other) with heels (for security purposes);
- Mosquito repellent;
- Sunscreen.

Other optional items

- Costumes and funny old garments for the closing celebration evening;
- Musical instruments.
